OUR IMPACT

Bright Horizons Fund (BHF) provides financial support and a holistic range of programmes for preschool children from low-income families. These programmes cater to the children's overall learning and well-being and have impacted 5,103 children between January and June 2023.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROGRAMMES



NTUC FIRST CAMPUS SPONSORED NTUC MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMME

2,896 Families

This programme enables low-income families to access the various financial and employability benefits for NTUC members. This privilege will continue till their child or youngest child leaves NTUC First Campus' preschool network.

OCBC-NTUC FIRST CAMPUS BRIDGING PROGRAMME

This programmes offers children from low-income families who are newly enrolled in My First Skool centres to receive a one-time \$400 top-up into their Child Development Account. In addition, OCBC Bank has organised two Financial Literacy Workshop in April and June and four families have participated.

BRIGHT HORIZONS FUND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEMES

This support includes financial assistance for Childcare Fees, School Uniforms and Field Trip Expenses

OCBC Financial Literacy Workshop provided us financial management. We are eager to participate in more of these programmes in the future!
