

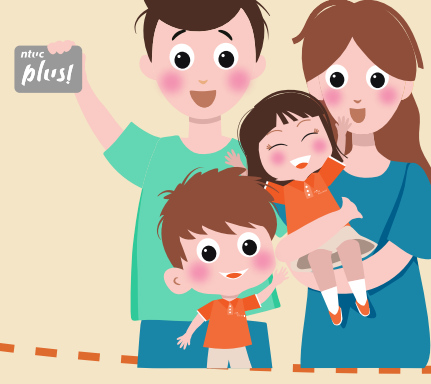
Hello!

Let me share how BHF helped needy families amid tough times and kept our dreams alive!



In 2021, BHF launched four new programmes to increase financial support for families, and bridged learning gaps worsened by the pandemic.



NTUC FIRST CAMPUS SPONSORED NTUC MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMME

2,700 Families

received NTUC Membership sponsored at S\$117 per annum (one parent per family) to enjoy the various financial and employability benefits offered by NTUC.



NTUC FIRST CAMPUS ONE-OFF CDA TOP-UP PROGRAMME

4,300 Children

received a one-off \$400 disbursement to their Child Development Account (CDA), to help defray various child-raising expenses.



DIGITAL KAMPUNG PROGRAMME

315 Children

received loaned iPads to help with digital learning.



FOOD & NUTRITION PROGRAMME

2,900 Food Packs

(worth \$60 each) were distributed.

2,500 Families

received Kopitiam Cards (worth \$40).



A total of 180 families attended the Food & Nutrition Workshop in which families gained valuable health and nutrition knowledge to help their children through the crucial developmental years.

In September, 5,400 Food & Nutrition themed Family Bonding Kits were distributed to families to encourage parent-child bonding.

On top of the new programmes that were launched this year, Bright Horizons Fund continued to provide support in other ways:

OCBC-NTUC First Campus Bridging Programme

535 Children

received \$400 in their Child Development Account (CDA) through OCBC's generous support. OCBC also organised digital Financial Literacy Workshops, which equipped participants with the necessary money management skills.



CapitaLand-Bright Horizons Fund Ready-For-School Programme: Classroom Support Programme

550 Children

benefitted from the Classroom Support Programme, of which, 190 children came from the 7 centres funded by CapitaLand-Bright Horizons Fund Ready-For-School Programme

1,070 Children

received school bags with essentials to get them ready for primary school!

received art kits to nurture their creativity.

received help to raise their English Literacy levels



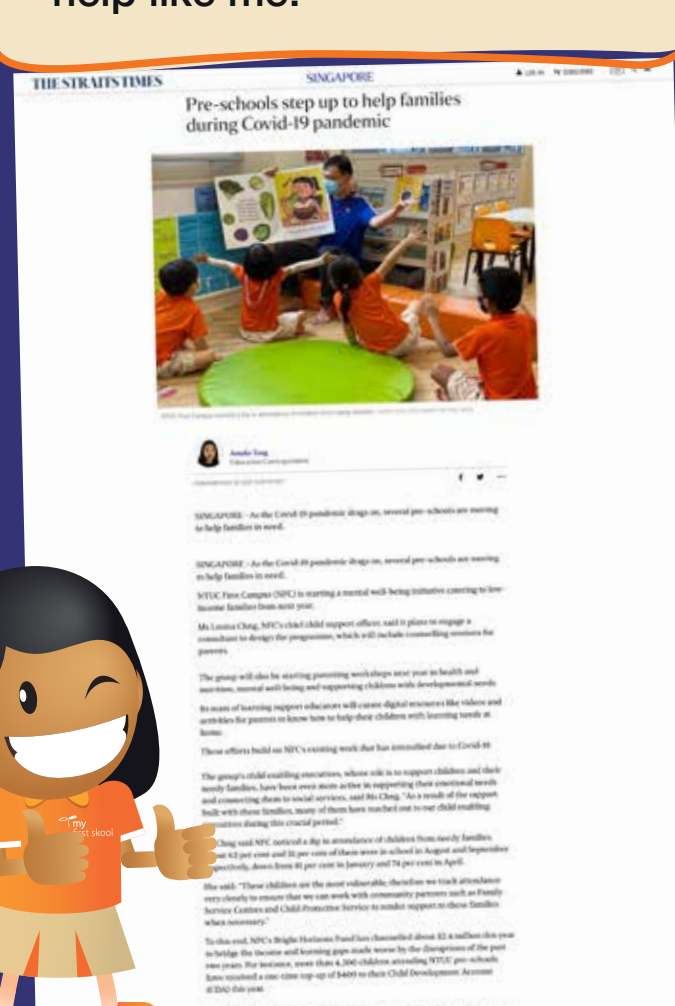
Bright Horizons Fund Financial Assistant Schemes

1,050 Children

received financial support from Bright Horizons Fund. These included the 100% net fee support for 6 months, Financial Assistance for infants and Child Care Fees, Start-Up Grant, School Uniforms and Field Trips Expenses.



Let me share with you a story of a family who also received help like me!



Mdm Zhu Su Qing, 36, and her husband, are both hawker assistants. Their youngest daughter, aged 6, attends NFC's My First Skool centre in Boon Lay.

Their monthly income was cut several times when the couple had to stop work due to the COVID-19 pandemic. With help from the Bright Horizons Fund, she could focus on caring for her children. She shared,

"The school has helped us a lot. We have received financial assistance that has helped us pay for her school fees and uniform. With the sponsored NTUC membership, we can also get discounts when buying groceries."
